LOCAL AGREEMENT**

Workload Points for OWI 2nd and 3rd Cases -(REVISED 9/30/10)


Upon mutual agreement with the Division of Community Corrections and AFSCME Local 2748, effective, August 1, 2010, the workload points for offenders placed on supervision for 2nd and 3rd Offense OWI will be 10 points for a period of sixty days for completion of an Intake Investigation.

After the initial sixty days intake period, offenders will be classified in either one of two tracks. If an offender is assessed as needing Track A supervision they would be classified Maximum Supervision for a minimum of 6 months. If offender is assessed as needing Track B supervision they would be classified Enhanced Supervision for 3 months. Unit Supervisors may extend the Maximum or Enhanced Supervision periods for an additional 3 months. All extensions of the enhanced supervision classification beyond 6 months shall be approved by the Regional Chief or Assistant Regional Chief.


If the offender is no longer in need of Maximum or Enhanced Supervision, the case will be supervised per Operations Manual.

The parties may by mutual agreement amend or add to this agreement. All addenda to this agreement shall be signed and ratified by the parties and shall be incorporated herein as though originally negotiated by the parties as a provision of this agreement, except that addenda may not take effect until the date they are signed by the parties.

If the Master Agreement is extended until renegotiated so shall this Local Agreement be extended until renegotiated. By mutual agreement, this agreement may be revisited after January 1, 2011.
